FIRST IMPRESSION

- ✓ **Your resume is the first impression that the employer will have you**
 - Take time to target your resume to the job description
- ✓ **There is a lot of competition in the job market**
 - Employers only spend 10 seconds viewing your resume
 - You need to make yours the one that gets noticed

PURPOSE OF RESUME

- ✓ To win an interview
- ✓ An advertisement of you
- ✓ To market your skills and accomplishments
- ✓ To provide contact information

RULES TO WRITING A RESUME

- ✓ Don't use more than 2 to 3 fonts and sizes
- ✓ Use bullet points to rather than paragraphs, easier to read
- ✓ Start CV with a summary of your objectives and qualifications
- ✓ List all your achievements from most recent
- ✓ Careful what you put on social networks e.g. Facebook, twitter etc
- ✓ Use action words to get the employers attention

KEY COMPONENTS

HEADER

- Name belongs at the top of the page
- Name should appear in bold in a slightly larger font (22-26pt)
- Include current contact information: mailing address, phone number, and email
